MOBRA STORY

Here is the never released story about the MOBRA.

In 1966, Carroll Shelby stashed a few Cobra bodies away for future use of two of his employees, then contacted Chrysler drag-race engine builder Buddy Martin to build them a 426 Street Hemi for a special project.

The Hemi was fitted with aluminium Offenhauser heads, a Moon intake with 4 Weber IDA 58 mm cross-rams, and a New Process A-833 4 speed manual transmission. These two employees contacted Carroll and wanted the go-ahead and he said "OK", as he didn't really like Ford and was there for his own purposes. The Mobra, as it was dubbed, was fitted with the aforementioned 426 Hemi and 4speed, along with a Chrysler Dana 60 posi-traction rear end with 4.11 gears, and the complete interior from the standard Cobra, and a '65 Barracuda shifter was fitted to the car. This is where it gets muddled. There were supposedly 7 made, 4 with Webers, and 3 with Hilborn fuel injection, all with 4 speeds. They were driven and tested around Buckinghamshire and near Newcastle-on-Avon, and from what I could tell all 7 still exist in the US, UK, and Switzerland. Then in '67 when Ford introduced the GT40, a prototype was acquired, and Carroll, Dan Gurney, and Bruce McClaren met secretly to build a Hemi-powered GT40. This engine was also built by Buddy Martin and had Hillborn 1500 cfm injection, ZF 5speed transaxle. This car was never seen after '68, when loaded on a US bound ship. Its whereabouts remain unknown.....
