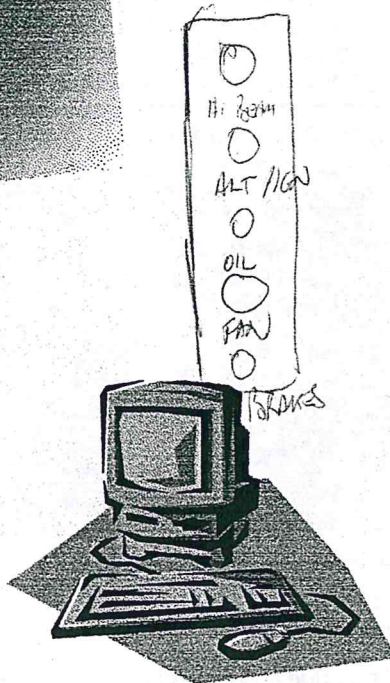

for the event and never, so we are told got a speeding ticket. (Missed your copper mate at Williams that hides

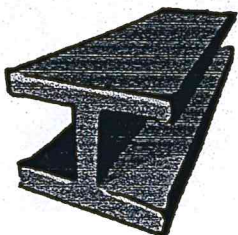
behind the trees did we Dave?)

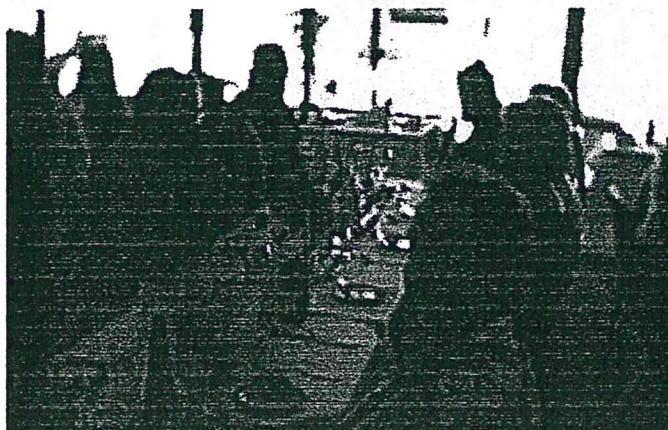
A good turn out of members enjoyed the freindship, food, drinks and laughter to celebrate Xmas and for the awarding of the year 2000 Club Trophies.

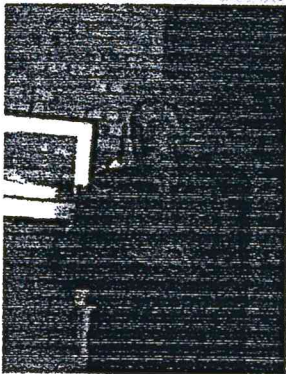

YOU WANT TO BE 'BEST CLUBMAN' FOR 2001?

Well here are the facts for you to achieve that goal.....

1. Activities/events attracting points for members who:

- a) Administer basic functions of the Club
- b) Attend monthly Club meetings
- c) Attend Club events
- d) Organise Club events

Definitions:

- A) All committee members, including members inducted for:
 - i) Temporary committee member duties
 - ii) Sub-committee members
 - iii) Club delegates, and
 - iv) Assistants as directed by committee.
- Max 1 point per month

B) At the current Club rooms or locations as directed by the committee

Max 2 points per meeting

C) Attend or participate in any Club organised event other than monthly meetings.

Max 4 points per event

D) Members (1) (singly or jointly) who organise and administer events approved by or in conjunction with the Club Captain.

Max 10 points per event.

2. In the event of a draw the award will be determined by a countback in reverse order at paragraph (1) ie d, c, b, and a.

3. The award will be an annual event from AGM to AGM the following year

as defined in the Cobra Car Club of WA Inc. Constitution, with a perpetual and annual trophy both bearing the year and winners name being present annually.

4. The Club Captain or his delegate will be responsible for the administration of the Award and presented monthly on the Notice Board reading monthly arrears.

5. All disputes regarding the Award will be adjudicated by the President, Vice president and Club Captain.

NOTE

(1) Committee members eligible for 11 points per annum, and members requesting to organise a second event in any one financial year will only be considered after all first time requests have been processed.
